

NORMS SET FOR DISCHARGE OF FUNCTIONS

The Council shall manage and control the affairs and finances of the ACI and shall have all administrative and other powers (not required by the ACT to be exercised in a General Meeting) necessary for properly carrying out the objects of the ACI and in particular shall have power.

- a. To appoint and dissolve such Committees and Sub-Committees for executive, technical, flying research, contest, finance or any other aspect of ACI's activities which it deems proper, to determine the terms of reference of such Committees and to delegate to such Committees such of the powers of the Council as it may think fit, provided always that any regulation and bye-laws affecting the rights of Members proposed by such Committee or Sub-Committee shall be subject to the approval of the Council.
- b. To make, repeal, and amend all such bye-laws and regulations (not inconsistent with the provisions of the Act or these Rules) as may be considered necessary or desirable in connection with the conduct of the aviation activities of Members or other matters within the scope of the objects of the ACT, and to interpret and give ruling upon any such regulations or bye-laws.
- c. To determine all questions of dispute as to the construction and meaning of these Rules, the Competition Rules of the ACI and 'Code Sportif' of the FAI or any expressions therein or as to anything done or omitted by any Member in relation to aeronautics.
- d. To appoint, control, suspend, remove or dismiss the Secretary-General, Secretaries, Treasurers, Clerks, Agents or other servants of the Club; and fix and pay their salaries and remunerations .
